Rules & Regulations

- Competition is open to the NYS Holstein Association. Entrants do not need to belong to the Monroe County Club. Multiple entries accepted.
Division “Y” are exhibitors who must not have reached their 21st birthday by January 1 in the year competing. Members who become 21 years of age during the current year will be allowed to compete in Youth Division until December 31 of the current year but not beyond this time. Exhibitors must be Junior members of the New York Holstein Association. Check age grouping on entry form.
Division “A” are exhibitors age 22 and over. Check age grouping on entry form.
- No exhibitor shall be allowed to receive more than two premiums for any one class.
- Animals will be judged Sunday at 10:00 am.
- Entry fee is 20% of first premium for group classes. \$10 entry fee for all other classes..
- Exhibitors can bring animals to the fair starting Sunday, July 8 after 1:00 pm. and they must be in place by Noon Friday. All exhibitors are invited to enter the Monroe County Fair Open Dairy Show (see entry rules and separate entry form). Animals must remain at fair until 6pm on Sunday, July 15.
- Registration certificates should be available for inspection and must show ownership by June 15, 2007. All animals to be shown must be registered with Holstein USA, and the animals must be 87% RHA or higher.
- Animals must follow all livestock requirements (see front of book).
- Use Finger Lakes Regional Holstein Show entry form (back of book). Mail entries to the Monroe County Fair, 2695 East Henrietta Road, Henrietta, New York 14467.
- Showmanship will be held first.
- Because of space limitations, extra hay and straw must be stored in exhibitor’s trailer.

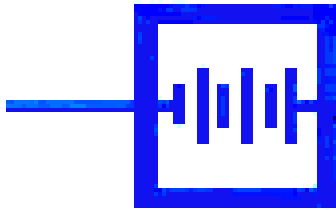
