

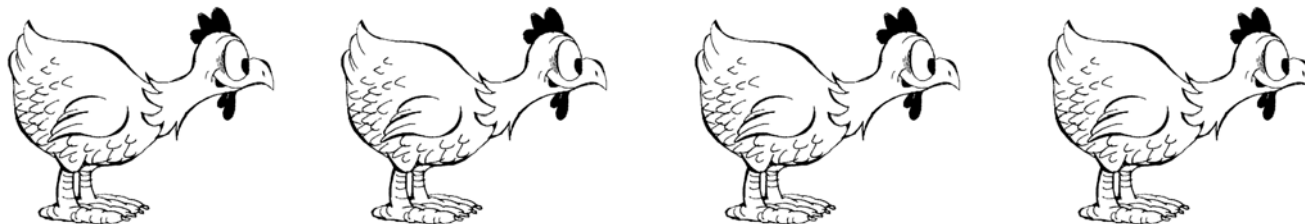

Rules & Regulations

- Entry fee for Single is \$.50 and Trios is \$ 1.00. All checks and money orders for entry fees should be made out to the Monroe County Fair & Recreation Association, Inc.
- No entry fee is required for entries in the Monroe County Fair Rooster Crowing Contest if exhibitor is entered elsewhere.
- Entries must be made out on a regulation entry blank with entry fee enclosed and class numbers shown. Copies of entry blank are acceptable.
 Youth are exhibitors under age 19. On entry form, use "C" (Children) or "T" (Teen) under Division.
 Adults are exhibitors ages 19 and over. On entry form, use "A" (Adult) under Division.
- Show is governed by the rules set up by the American Poultry Association unless otherwise specified. ALL general rules of the fair also apply.
- The Fair Association will not be responsible for any loss that may occur but the greatest care will be exercised in guarding the health of the birds.
- The management reserves the right to reject any entries that it deems unworthy of admittance.
- It is recommended that all birds be vaccinated against Infectious Laryngotracheitis, Newcastle and Bronchitis at least one month before the fair.
- Birds affected with any contagious disease will be returned to the owner or isolated from the poultry building. Daily inspections of all entries will be made. Birds removed by veterinarian or birds substituted for birds removed must be examined by the veterinarian before they are returned to the show.
- A cock or hen shall constitute a specimen one year or more of age. Cockerel or pullet shall constitute a specimen under one year of age.
- Exhibitors from one family cannot make entries in more than 20 varieties in Large Fancy Poultry or Bantams.
- No one other than owner or show management will be permitted to open any coop or to handle any specimen without permission of the Superintendent.
- All Poultry, except waterfowl and pigeons, shown at state or county fairs, shall present proof of either having originated from U.S. Pullorum clean flocks or have been found negative to a Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days of the fair.
- Exhibitors – A nominal fee will be charged to each breeder for feed on a per-head entered basis.
- Specimens may be brought to fairgrounds from 7:00-10:00pm., Tuesday, July 10 and must be in place by Wednesday, July 11 before 10:00 am. Judging: Friday, July 13 at 7:00 pm.
- No exhibits may leave fairgrounds until 7:00 pm. the last day of the Fair. Prize money will be mailed as soon as possible.
- Any exhibitors wishing to sell animals at the fair must have permission from the department superintendent and must pay fair a 20% commission on all sales.

In order to have your flock tested, please contact State of New York, Department of Agriculture & Markets, 10-B Airline Dr, Albany, New York 12235, phone 518-457-5558. An appointment will be set for your flock to be tested. If you want one individual bird from the flock tested, please get in touch with your veterinarian.

Rules & Regulations

- The Monroe County Fair “Rooster Crowing” Contest will be held from 1:30 pm to 2:00 pm & 5:30 pm to 6:00 pm, Friday & Saturday. The total number of crows will determine winners over 3 days.
- Contest is open to the World.
- Entry fee \$ 2.00. Check must be sent with entry. Please use separate entry blank.
- An exhibitor can enter one or two roosters in the contest.
- Contests will be based solely on the number of “crows” recorded during specified periods and not the volume, tone or musical quality. The male having the most crows recorded to his credit at the end of the fair will be declared Champion. Number of crows recorded during a 30-minute period each of two days.
- All breeds, mixed breeds and varieties of poultry are eligible.
- Any ties will be “Crowed Off” by rules set up by the committee.
- Any special cases not covered by the rules will be acted upon by the general committee in charge of the contest.
- Qualified recorders will be assigned to record the number of crows during the specified time. Roosters will be penned in individual coops and handlers may use any method to get their exhibit to crow without touching the bird or cage.
- Monroe County Fair reserves the right to use the Grand Champion and Reserve Champion on TV programs or such other publicity as required.
- Rooster crowing class is limited to the first 12 birds – entries close July 2, 2007.
- Champion and Reserve Champion Roosters will be invited to enter the State Fair Rooster Crowing Contest in Syracuse.
