Rules & Regulations

- The show is open to all registered and recognized purebred, American and Grade does.
- No horns allowed.
- The show is sanctioned by A.D.G.A. for the following breeds, in the order to be shown: ALPINE ... LAMANCHA ... NUBIAN ... OBERHASLI ... SAANAN ... TOGGENBURG ... RECORDED GRADE.
(Recorded grades will be shown in age classes, not separated according to breeds.)
- The base date for computing age is July 13, 2009.
- Official A.D.G.A. rules will govern the show.
- The show will be held rain or shine. Food concessions available throughout fairgrounds. A limited number of 9'x9' pens will be available the day of the show.
- Each exhibitor must present written documentation to prove that all animals brought onto the grounds conform to the State of New York Department of Agriculture and Markets Livestock Health requirements as revised 1/2009.
- The Monroe County Fair is requiring that all goats be vaccinated against rabies. See "Rabies Vaccination" on page 15.
- No animal will be allowed to unload without health check. Decision of veterinarian and the show committee will be final.
- Judging to begin promptly at 11am on Sunday, July 19.
- Be sure that the tattoo on your doe is clear before entering the ring.
- Entry fee will be 20% of the first place premium. Mail entry forms and fees to: Monroe County Fair, 2695 East Henrietta Road, Henrietta, New York 14467, by July 6, 2009. Entries must be received by that date.
- The original registration certificate is required for all animals six months of age or older and must be shown to the show secretary before the start of the show. No copies, telegrams or phone calls will be accepted in lieu of the aforementioned.
- No pre-show milk out.
- Specialty classes will be broken down according to breed and all animals shown in these classes must be entered in the regular classes.
- No refunds.
- Deadline for entries is July 6. Late entry by special arrangement with show committee only.
- Junior and Senior does are not separately sanctioned.
- Competition is open to all.
Youth are exhibitors under age 19. On entry form, use "C" (Children 8-12 years of age) or "T" (Teen) under Division.
Adults are exhibitors ages 19 and over. On entry form, use "A" (Adult) under Division.
