A nominal fee will be charged each breeder for feed on a per-head basis. (Include with entry)

## Entry Fees:

Single Class - \$ .80; Litter Classes - \$ 1.25; Fur Classes - \$ .50

Animal Feed: \$0.25 per head (or supply own feed)

## Rules & Regulations

- Classes for sexes and varieties within breeds will be provided as recognized by the American Rabbit Breeders Association.
- All rabbits must have a permanent tattoo in the left ear. Cavies must have ear tags in the left ear.
- Clearly list department, age division of exhibitor, section, class, tattoo number, color and breed on regulation entry blank. Copies are acceptable.
  - Youth are exhibitors under age 19. Use "C" (Children 12 and under) or "T" (Teen) under Division on entry form.
  - Adults are exhibitors ages 19 and over. Use "A" (Adult) under Division on entry form.
- Adults and Youth animals will be shown together. Youth exhibitors will be awarded within their class. There is no separate youth show.
- All animals present must be entered in their proper classes and sections to be eligible for judging.
- Angora breeders must provide their own wire bottoms for cages. Cages are 21" x 20-1/4".
- Any diseased or unsightly specimen will be rejected by the superintendent or veterinarian at any time during the show. Exhibitor will be asked to remove specimen from show room.
- Coop identification cards must remain on coops at all times.
- Animal sales will be handled through the show superintendent. Only the animals entered in the show may be sold. All transactions will be managed by the superintendent and paperwork/money will be provided to the seller at the end of the fair. Pedigrees for any animals will be left with the superintendent to provide to the buyer. There will be a sales board posted prominently.
- There is a 20% commission on all sales and that will be collected by the superintendent.
- Owner or show personnel are the only ones allowed to handle the animals.
- Please read GENERAL RULES in front of Exhibitors Handbook for pass information.
- Owners may feed and water their own stock. Please provide feed dishes and water bottles. The Fair may provide food, but there will be a charge of \$.50 per head. Please provide this fee with your entry.
- Stacking cages will not be allowed unless provided by the Fair.
- Rabbits will be received from 7pm to 10pm on Tuesday, July 14 and from 9am to 10am Wednesday, July 15.
- Judging: Wednesday, July 15 at 6pm. It is recommended that exhibitors be present during the show.
- The barn will close at 7pm on Sunday, July 19<sup>th</sup>. No animals may leave prior to this time. Exhibitors should plan on assisting with the takedown of the exhibit.

## Special Awards

All other breeds shown will be awarded a ribbon by the Rochester Rabbit Breeders' Association. The Rochester Rabbit Breeders' Association will also award special award ribbons for Best of Breed and Reserve of Breed for cavies shown.
