- Multiple entries accepted.
 - Youth are exhibitors under age 19: On entry form, use “C” (Children 12 and under) or “Y” (Youth) under “Division”.
 - Adults are exhibitors ages 19 and over: On entry form, use “A” (Adult) under “Division”.
- No exhibitors shall be allowed to receive more than two premiums for any one class.
- Mail entry forms to: Monroe County Fair, 2695 East Henrietta Rd., Henrietta, NY 14467
- Animals will be judged Saturday at Noon.
- Entry fee will be 20% of the first place premium. Please include entry fee when returning entry blank.
- Exhibitors can bring animals to the fair starting on Sunday, July 11 after 1pm and must be in place by Wednesday, July 14 at Noon.
- Registration certificates should be available for inspection and must show ownership 60 days prior to opening day of the Fair. Animals may be released Sunday, July 18 at 7pm.
- Because of space limitations, extra hay and straw must be stored in exhibitor's trailer.
- All animals need to be secured with halters and neck ties.
- Bulls over eight months of age must have nose ring in place at all times.
- Camper parking will pay \$50 for the week whether you hook up or not. This is to be paid with entry.
