## Rules & Regulations

- Competition is open to all. Multiple entries accepted.
  - Youth are exhibitors under age 19. On entry form, use “C” (Children 12 and under) or “Y” (Youth) under Division.
  - Adult are exhibitors ages 19 and over. On entry form, use “A” (Adult) under Division.
- No exhibitor shall be allowed to receive more than two premiums for any one class.
- Entry fee is 20% of first premium.
- Registration certificates should be available for inspection and must show ownership 60 days prior to opening day of the Fair. All Holsteins with 87% registered Holstein ancestry and above are eligible to show in the Holstein section.
- Mail entry forms to the Monroe County Fair, 2695 East Henrietta Road, Henrietta, New York 14467.
- As stalling is limited, pre-entry is necessary so that we can accommodate animals.
- All showmanship classes (classes 1-5) will be judged Thursday, July 15 at 6:30pm along with all heifer classes of all breeds, junior herd and junior championship (classes 6-16).
- All milking animals, including classes 17-27, of all breeds, will be judged Friday, July 16 starting at 6:30pm. Junior champions should be available at this time for grand champion judging.
- No premiums will be allowed any animal that does not show merit.
- Exhibitors can bring animals to the fair starting Sunday, July 11 after 1pm and must be in place by Wednesday, July 14 at Noon. Animals may be released Sunday, July 18 at 7pm. **ANIMALS MUST BE SUPERVISED.**
- Barn must be ready for inspection by 10am every day.
- Because of space limitations, extra hay and straw must be stored in exhibitor's trailer.
- All exhibitors must wear white pants, shorts or skirts with colored or white shirts while showing in individual, group or championship classes.
- Camper parking will pay \$50 for the week whether you hook-up or not. This is to be paid with entries.
