**Rules & Regulations**

- Entry fee for Single is \$.50 and Trios is \$1.00. All checks and money orders for entry fees should be made out to the Monroe County Fair & Recreation Association, Inc.
- No entry fee is required for entries in the Monroe County Fair Rooster Crowing Contest if exhibitor is entered elsewhere.
- Entries must be made out on a regulation entry blank with entry fee enclosed and class numbers shown. Copies of entry blank are acceptable.
- Show is governed by the rules set up by the American Poultry Association unless otherwise specified. ALL general rules of the fair also apply.
- The Fair Association will not be responsible for any loss that may occur but the greatest care will be exercised in guarding the health of the birds.
- The management reserves the right to reject any entries that it deems unworthy of admittance.
- It is recommended that all birds be vaccinated against Infectious Laryngotracheitis, Newcastle and Bronchitis at least one month before the fair.
- Birds affected with any contagious disease will be returned to the owner or isolated from the poultry building. Daily inspections of all entries will be made. Birds removed by veterinarian or birds substituted for birds removed must be examined by the veterinarian before they are returned to the show.
- A cock or hen shall constitute a specimen one year or more of age. Cockerel or pullet shall constitute a specimen under one year of age.
- Exhibitors from one family cannot make entries in more than 20 varieties in Large Fancy Poultry or Bantams.
- No one other than owner or show management will be permitted to open any coop or to handle any specimen without permission of the Superintendent.
- All Poultry, except waterfowl and pigeons, shown at state or county fairs, shall present proof of having originated from United States pullorum-clean flocks or have been found negative to a Pullorum-Typhoid test within 90 days of the fair.
- Specimens may be brought to fairgrounds from 7pm -10pm, Tuesday, July 13 and must be in place by Wednesday, July 14 before 10am  
Judging: Friday, July 16 at 7pm.
- No exhibits may leave fairgrounds until 7pm. the last day of the Fair. Prize money will be mailed as soon as possible.

In order to have your flock tested, please contact State of New York, Department of Agriculture & Markets, 10-B Airline Dr, Albany, New York 12235, phone 518-457-5558. An appointment will be set for testing of your flock.

On-site Pullorum-Typhoid testing for poultry entered in the Fair will be available Tuesday, between 7pm and 8pm and Wednesday 9am-10am ONLY! No birds will be tested after these times. No bird will enter the building without completion or proof of such testing.

This contest has much practical value, as crowing indicates vim and vigor. Crowing contests have been a feature of Brussels, Belgium shows for many years, the theory being that the lustily crowing male is a worthy mate for the thrifty laying hen.

#### Rules & Regulations

- The Monroe County Fair “Rooster Crowing” Contest will be held from 1:30pm to 2pm & from 5:30pm to 6pm on Friday, Saturday & Sunday. The total number of crows over the three days will determine winners.
- Contest is open to the world.
- Entry fee \$2.00. Check must be sent with entry. Please use separate entry blank. NOTE: No entry fee is required if rooster is entered in other class competitions.
- Contests will be based solely on the number of “crows” recorded during specified periods and not the volume, tone or musical quality. The male having the most crows recorded to his credit at the end of the fair will be declared Champion. Number of crows recorded during a 30-minute period each of three days.
- All breeds, mixed breeds and varieties of poultry are eligible.
- Any ties will be “Crowed Off” by rules set up by the committee.
- Any special cases not covered by the rules will be acted upon by the general committee in charge of the contest.
- Qualified recorders will be assigned to record the number of crows during the specified time. Roosters will be penned in individual coops and handlers may use any method to get their exhibit to crow without touching the bird or cage.
- Monroe County Fair reserves the right to use the Grand Champion and Reserve Champion on TV programs or such other publicity as required.
