Rules & Regulations

- One may enter as many classes as he / she wishes.
- One may enter only two entries per Class.
- All entries must be made by the entrant and completed in the last three years.
- Entries must NOT have been previously entered in the Monroe County Fair.
- The Exhibitor's Handbook is available online at www.mcfair.com or by calling 585-334-4000.

Deadlines

- Entry forms **MUST** be received by July 1.
- Entry items **MUST** be received no later than July 9, 2011.

Divisions

- A – adults ages 19 & over, T – teen ages 13 – 18, Y – child ages 9 – 12, C – child ages 5 - 8

Fees

- Entry Fee: None
- Late Fee: \$ 5.00 per person for entry forms received after July 1, 2011.

Delivery of Entries

- Drop-off at County Fairgrounds: Friday, July 8, 2011 from 3pm-7pm or, Saturday, July 9, 2011 from 9am-Noon.
- Mail In: Monroe County Fair – 2695 East Henrietta Road – Henrietta, NY 14467 – Item(s) must be received by July 5, 2011. Package should contain entry form; cash in exact amount, money order or check made payable to “The Monroe County Fair” for entry fee; and item(s) being entered.
- To Have articles mailed back after the Fair: Include return postage and packaging.

Judging

- Judges reserve the right to determine eligibility of entries.
- Judges reserve the right to reclassify entries.
- Decision of the judge is final.
- Entries are judged on creativity and originality.
- Judging will take place July 10, 2011 (not open to the public).

Other Information

- Care and security for exhibits will be provided, but the Fair assumes no responsibility for loss or damage to exhibits from any cause.
- Entries can be picked up Monday, July 18, 2011, from 4pm-7pm ONLY.
- NO KITS are allowed.
- Robots can be made of any material, and may be miniature to android size.
- Adult entries must move or have some functionality.
- Other classes can be stationary models.
- Team entries are welcome, but all team members must be in the same age group.
- Robots may be made of any material, and may be miniature to android size.
